the library has stimming toys to use.



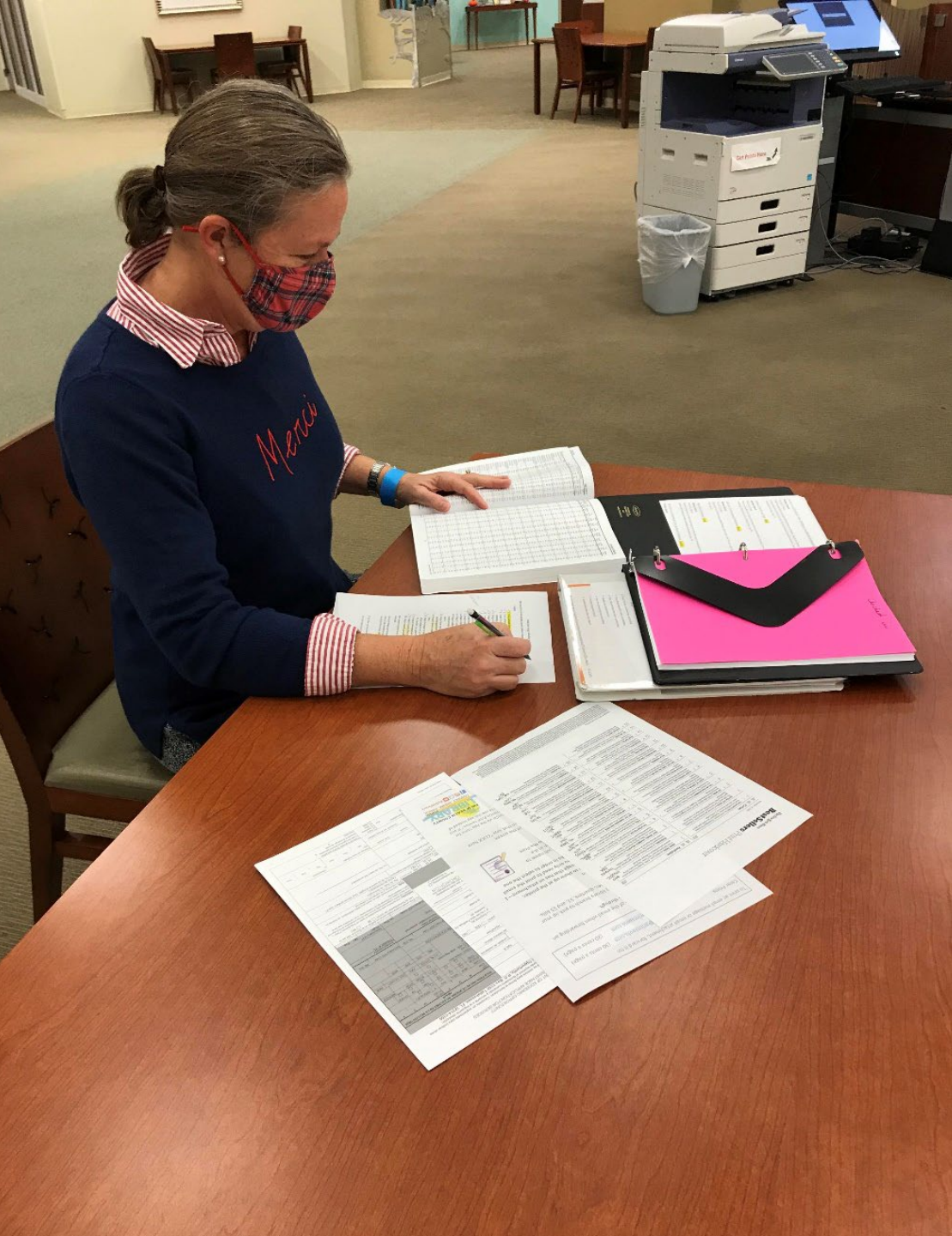
I can attend story time and fun classes in the Storytime Room at the library.
