Librarians are so nice!

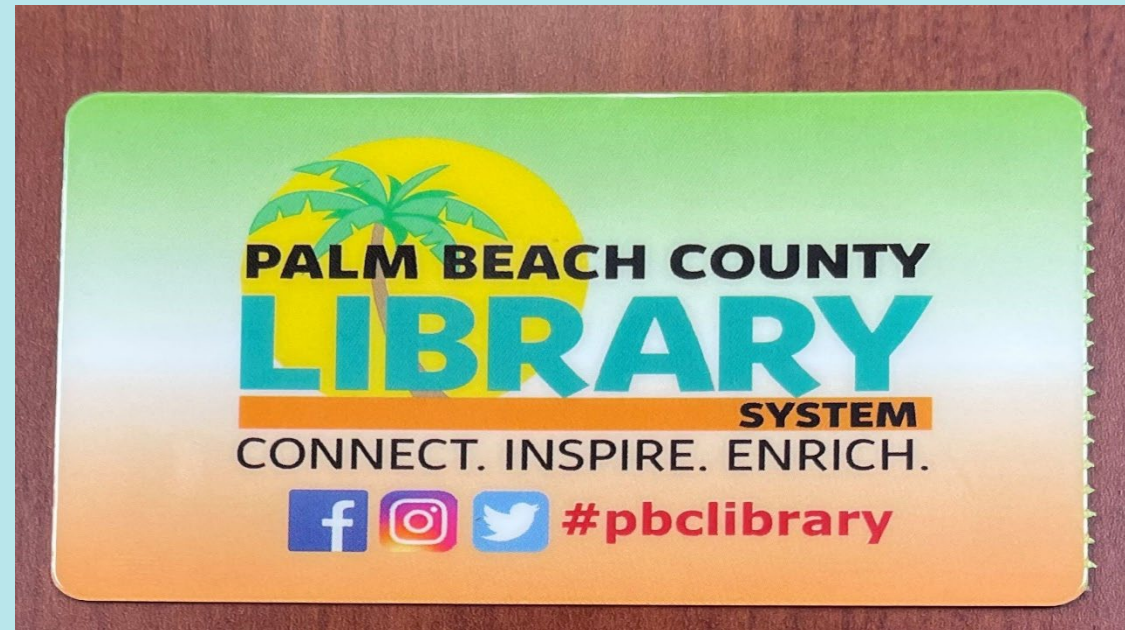


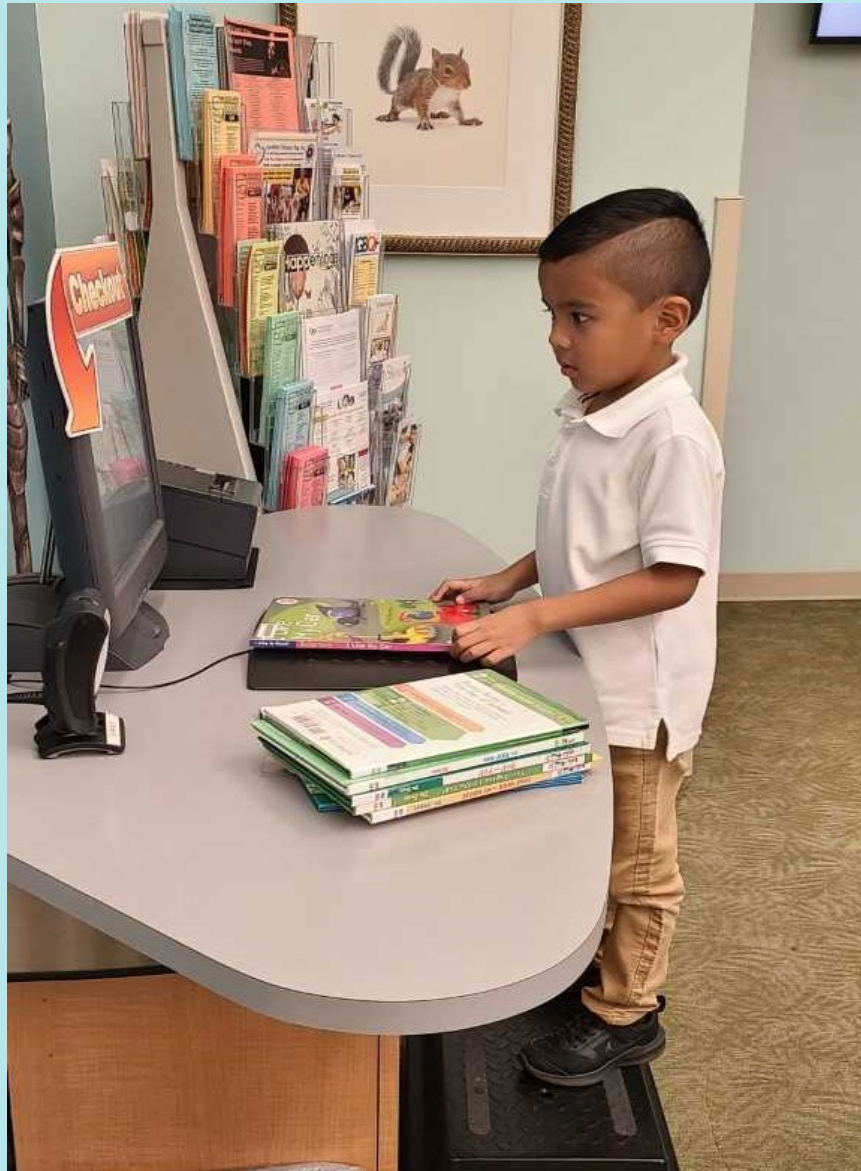


The library also
