A Social Story About Going to the Library




Before I enter the library on my right there is a machine that I can use to return books and DVDs.





When I first walk in, I see the lobby.








There are bathrooms and water fountains at the library that I can use at any time. I can find them in the lobby on my left.





The library has fun activities in the Multipurpose Room.




I can't wait to have fun!




Up ahead, I can see the Children's Area.








It's exciting to go to the library, so I will try to remember to walk instead of run.





I can play or read at the library.




If I need some help to calm down, the library has stimming toys to use.






Some people are studying, so I will use my quiet voice.
