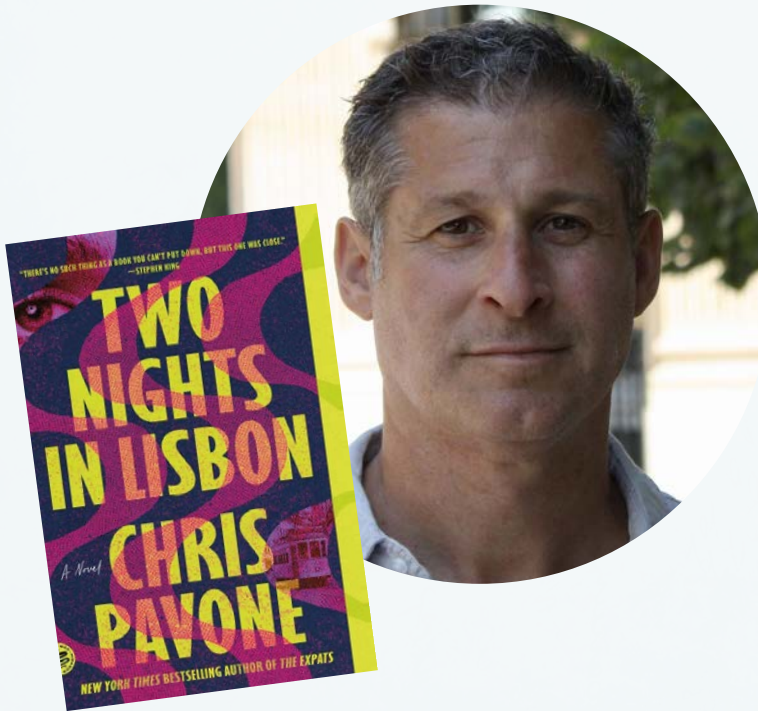

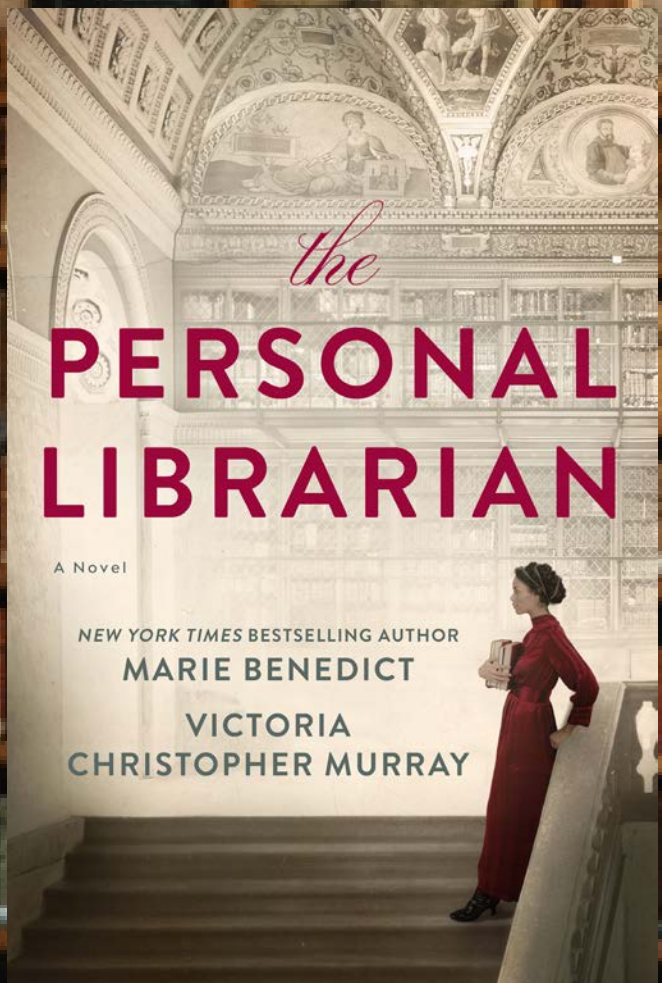
Audubon Birding Collection

For almost 45 years, the Library has enjoyed a special connection to Audubon Everglades as we have built one of the largest ornithological (birding) collections in the Southeast United States. Thomas P. McElroy Jr. stated at the dedication of the Audubon Collection on April 17, 1980, "I look upon this collection as a beginning – a beginning that could be expanded into one of the finest ornithological collections to be found anywhere." His words continue to ring true to this day!

Thanks to the support of Audubon Everglades and the Friends of the Library, novice birders and seasoned ornithologists flock to the Main Library to enjoy over 1,100 titles about birds from every corner of the earth. Even David Allen Sibley, the author of one of the most comprehensive guides to North American birds, visited the collection and admired its breadth.

This collection spans the gamut from basic bird watching and identification to scientific research dating back to the 1970s. Taking a vacation to Latin America? To China? To Texas? There's a birding guide you can borrow to pack for your trip. And while you're at it, you can also reserve a birding backpack, complete with a pair of adult binoculars, two children's binoculars and a guide to Florida birds. The Library's backpacks have already traveled to Peru, Germany and many of our local natural areas like Green Cay Wetlands in Delray Beach.

Make sure to check Happenings and the Library's website throughout the year to find birding-related activities for all ages across the County – both at your local branch and in parks. These activities are a great way to learn more about our fine feathered friends and enjoy all the beauty that South Florida nature has to offer. And if you find yourself migrating close to the Main Library, stop by and take a gander at the Audubon Collection – you'll find out why it's not just for the birds, it's about the birds!

Women Authors Who Used Male Pseudonyms

Throughout history, many women authors have chosen to write under male pseudonyms. Even in the 21st century, talented writers have adopted male pen names to ensure their works were taken seriously by a broader audience. In honor of Women's History Month, we're recognizing the following women as some of the well-known authors who chose to write under male aliases. Overcoming literary barriers, their achievements stand as a critique of the societal norms that necessitated such disguises. Their accomplishments are a reminder of the importance of evaluating work based on its merit, rather than the gender of its creator.

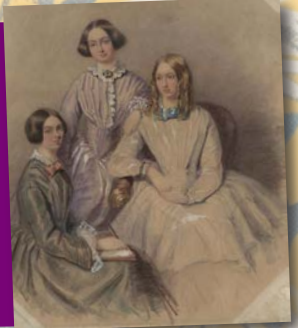


George Eliot (Mary Ann Evans)

Known for "Middlemarch" and "Silas Marner," Evans chose a male pen name to avoid stereotypes. She is celebrated for her novels' realism and psychological insight.

Currer, Ellis and Acton Bell (The Brontë Sisters)

Charlotte, Emily and Anne Brontë published as Currer, Ellis and Acton Bell, navigating the restrictive Victorian literary scene. Their classics include "Jane Eyre," "Wuthering Heights," and "The Tenant of Wildfell Hall."



George Sand (Amantine Lucile Aurore Dupin)

A 19th-century French novelist, Dupin's male pseudonym challenged gender norms. Her novels, like "Indiana" and "Lélia," often explored gender and class issues.



Vernon Lee (Violet Paget)

The Victorian era British writer Paget, was known as Vernon Lee. She wrote supernatural and aesthetic-themed works exploring psychology and philosophy.



James Tiptree, Jr. (Alice Bradley Sheldon)

Sheldon, a key figure in science fiction, used a male pseudonym to explore gender and identity themes. Her notable works include "The Girl Who Was Plugged In" and "Houston, Houston, Do You Read?"



Rob Thurman (Robyn Thurman)

Thurman, a New York Times Bestselling author, used her nickname for her urban fantasy series "Cal Leandros," revealing her identity after her third book's release.



D.C. Fontana (Dorothy Catherine Fontana)

Fontana was a pioneering television writer, particularly for "Star Trek." She used her initials to sidestep gender prejudice in a male-dominated industry.

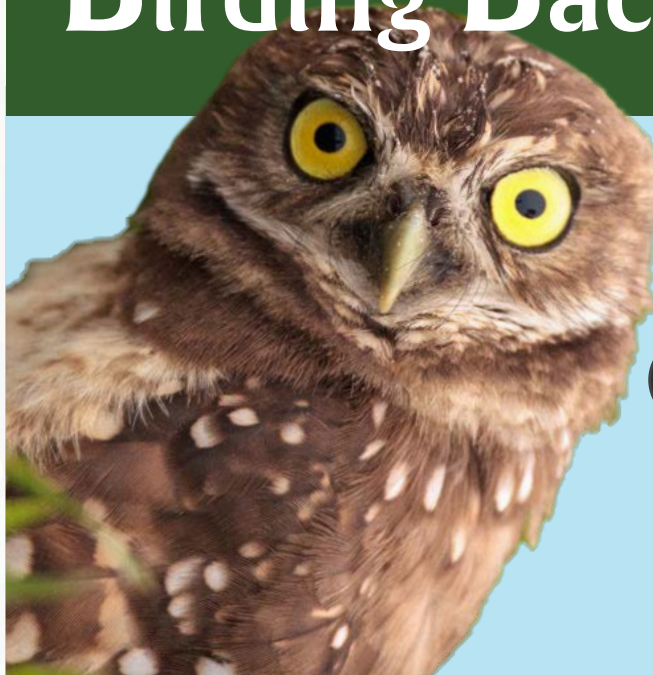
