Juneteenth, celebrated annually on June 19, marks the day in 1865 when Union soldiers, led by Major General Gordon Granger, arrived in Galveston, Texas, to announce the end of the Civil War and proclaim freedom for all enslaved individuals. This momentous occasion came two and a half years after President Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation, highlighting the delayed enforcement of emancipation in certain regions of the country.

As we commemorate Juneteenth, it's essential to reflect on the resilience of African Americans throughout history. From the horrors of slavery to the struggles for civil rights, African Americans have continuously fought for justice, equality and freedom. Juneteenth serves as a poignant reminder of the progress made and the work that remains in the ongoing pursuit of racial equality and social justice.

## PRIDE MONTH

June marks Pride Month, a significant period for the LGBTQ+ community to unite and honor their identities, heritage and triumphs. Originating from the pivotal Stonewall riots of 1969, which ignited a grassroots movement advocating for gay rights, this month serves as a commemoration and celebration. Notably, on June 11, 1999, President Bill Clinton issued the inaugural Presidential Proclamation of Gay and Lesbian Pride Month, further solidifying its recognition.

Libraries have historically championed diversity and inclusivity, serving as bastions of knowledge and platforms for celebrating various cultures, identities and viewpoints. They provide a nurturing environment for individuals to explore their sense of self and foster a feeling of belonging. During Pride Month, libraries actively promote initiatives aimed at dispelling stereotypes and fostering greater understanding and acceptance.

Pride Month serves as a moment to acknowledge the trials and triumphs of the LGBTQ+ community across history.
