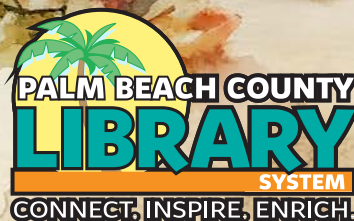

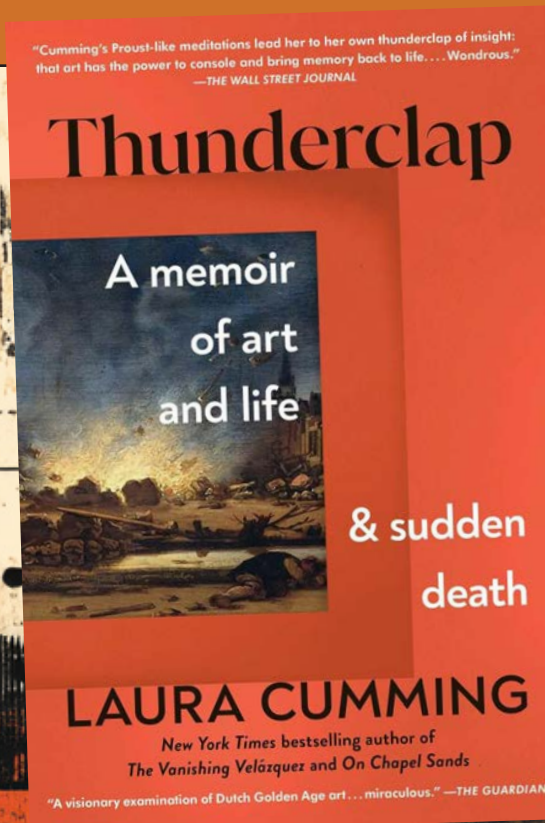

Throughout the month, discover works by Jewish authors and stories that explore themes of heritage, resilience, identity and imagination. From classic writers such as Isaac Bashevis Singer and Chaim Potok to contemporary voices like Nicole Krauss and Jonathan Safran Foer, Jewish literature offers perspectives that continue to inspire and connect readers of all backgrounds.

Visit your local branch to browse featured book displays or explore the Library's online catalog for a wide selection of novels, memoirs, poetry and nonfiction. Whether you're interested in tales of immigration, explorations of faith or modern fiction that captures today's diverse Jewish experiences, you'll find something to spark your interest.

Library staff are also available to recommend titles for adults, teens and youth. For readers who prefer digital formats, many Jewish-themed titles are available as eBooks and audiobooks through the Library's online services.

National Jewish Book Month provides an opportunity to celebrate the contributions of Jewish writers and to share stories that encourage conversation and understanding.
